**ORDER
DISMISSING APPEAL**


This appeal was filed by Ms. Sleeper-Guerrero on January 8, 2001, before the Tribal Court issued its final Decree. The record of proceedings below was transmitted to this court on April 2, 2001, after the Tribal Court (Stewart, J.) entered its final Decree for dissolution of the marriage on February 23, 2001. Acknowledging this unusual sequence of events, this court issued Scheduling Order on July 18, 2001, ordering Appellant Nancy Guerrero to file her brief or statement in support of her appeal on or before August 17, 2001. That Order also advised Ms. Guerrero that unless she filed a brief or statement in support of her appeal, this court would have no choice but to dismiss her appeal.

On October 9, 2001, this court entered an Order to Show Cause directing Ms. Sleeper-Guerrero to show cause in writing why this appeal should not be dismissed, by filing on or before October 22, 2001, her brief or statement in support of her appeal along with an explanation for why it was not filed within the original deadline. Ms. Guerrero was further advised that if she failed to file anything in support of her appeal by that time, her appeal would be subject to immediate dismissal. The Appellant has missed this second deadline, and has not requested any extension of time.


Now, therefore,
