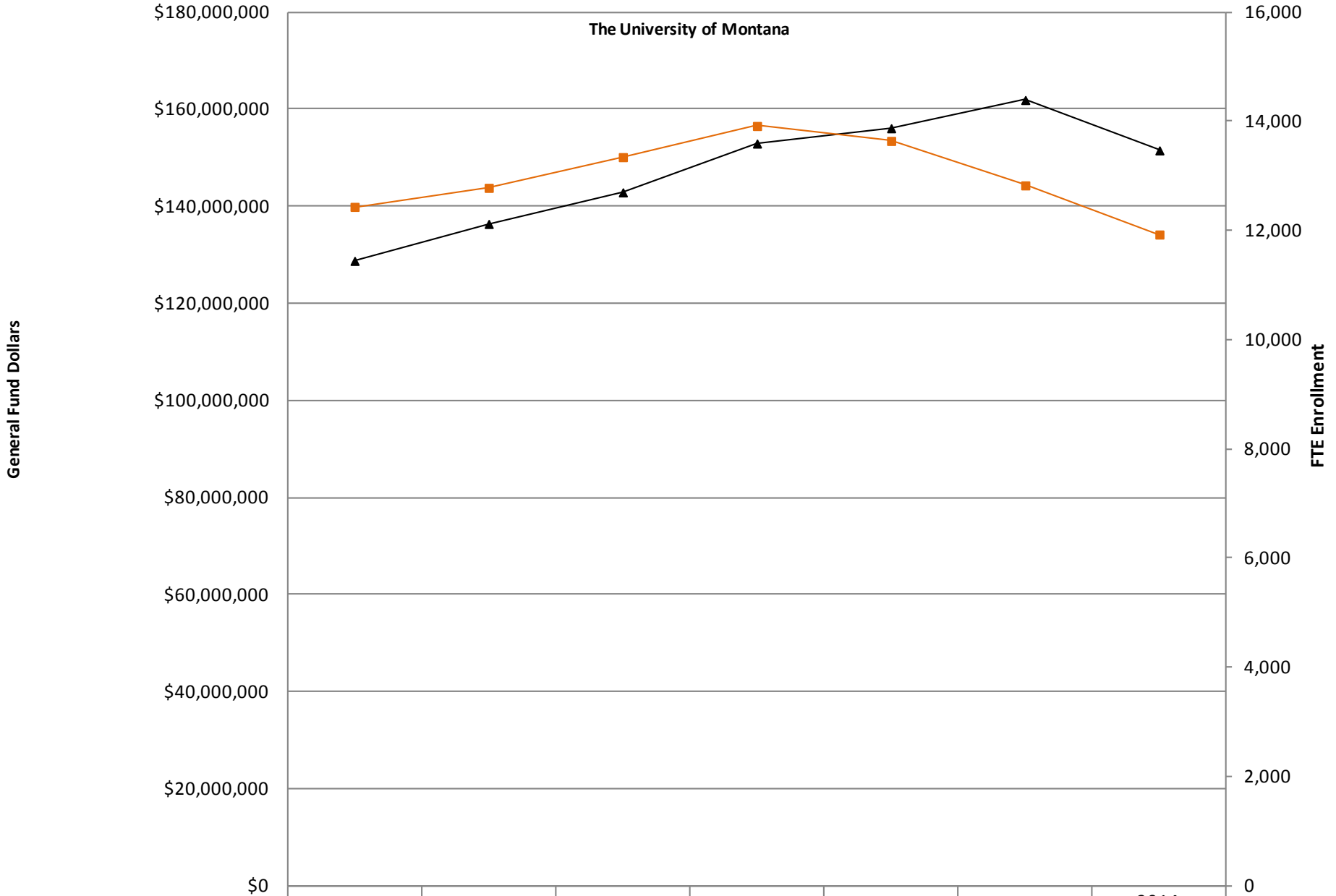
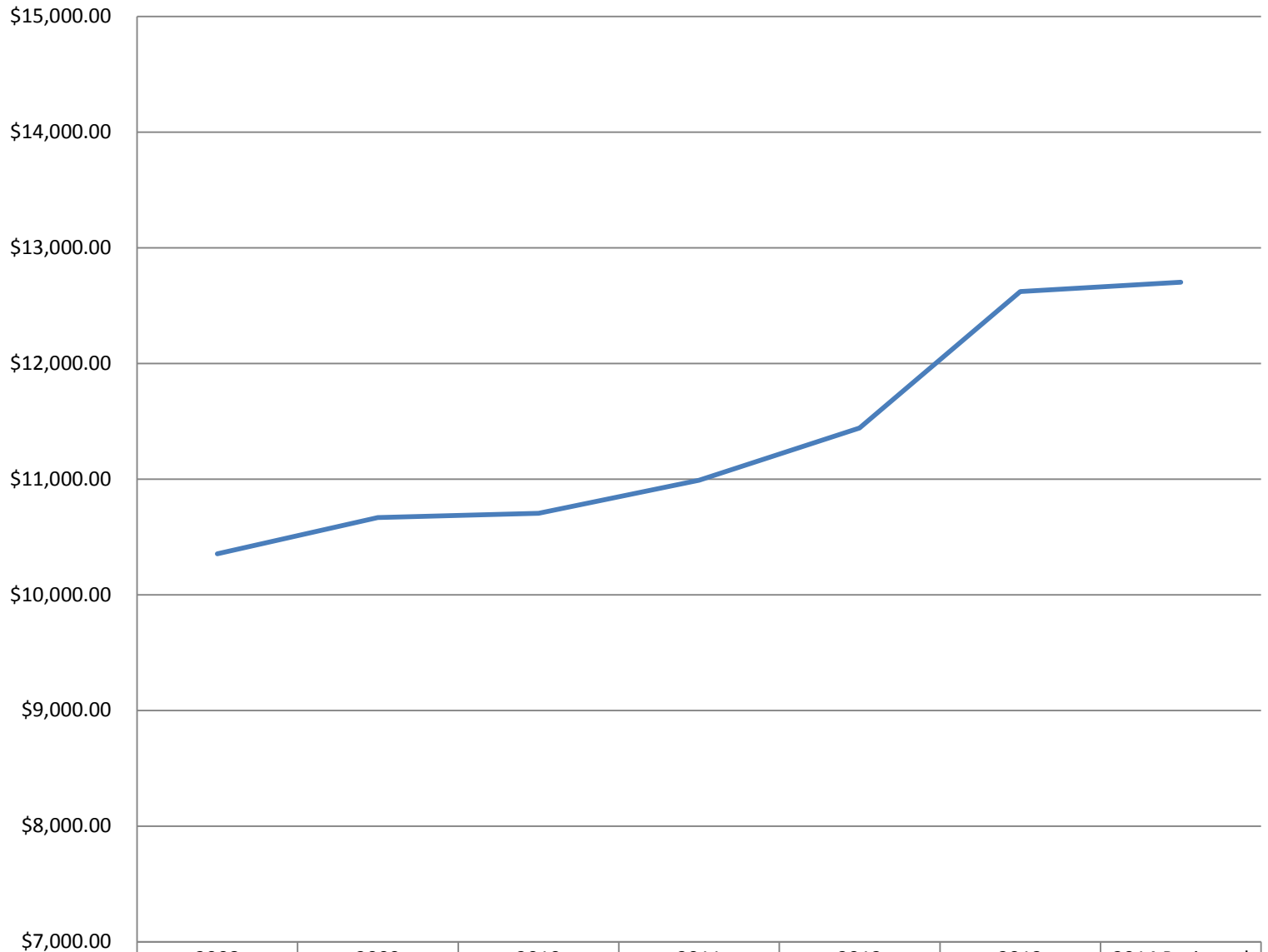

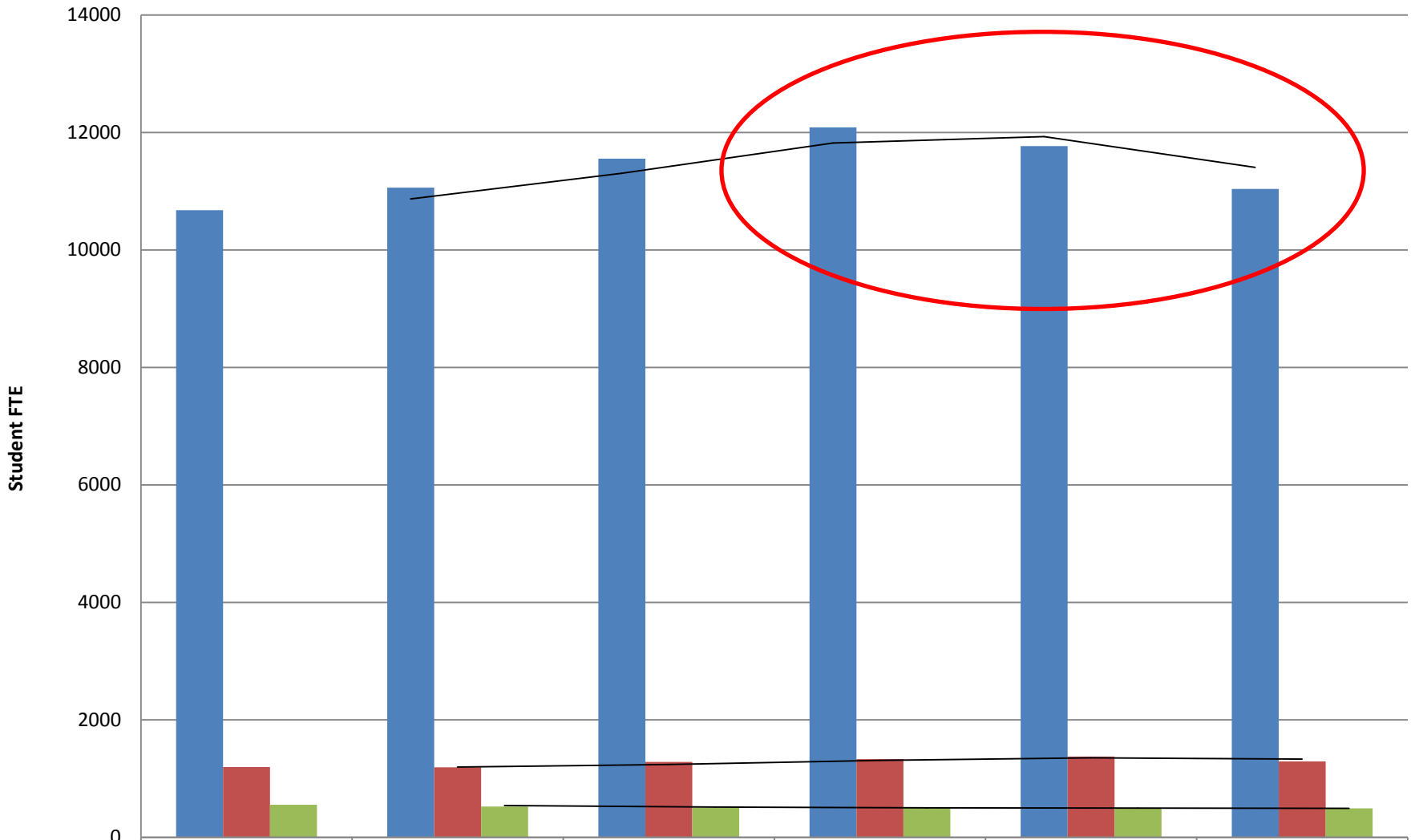

General Fund per Student FTE



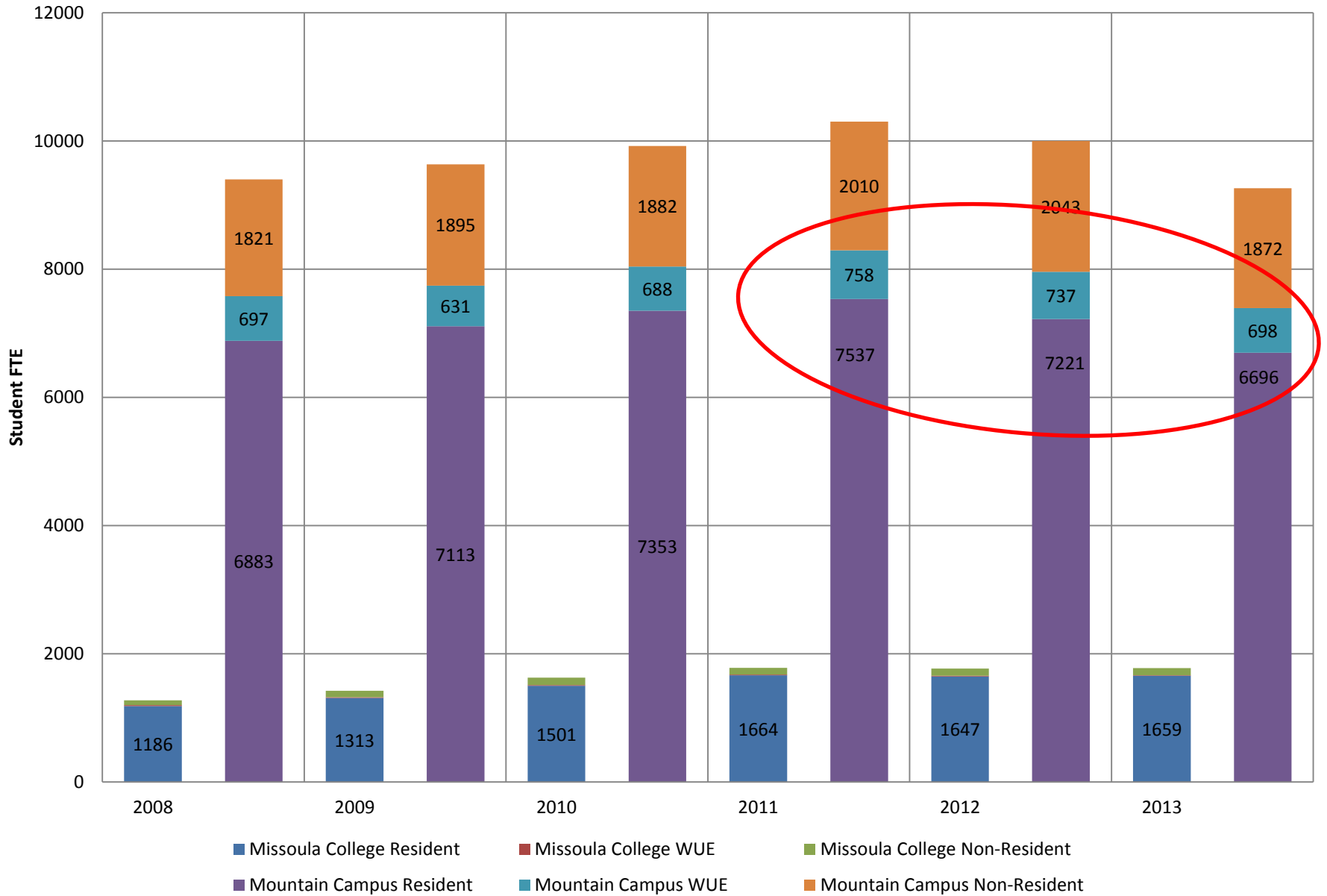

Total Student FTE by Class



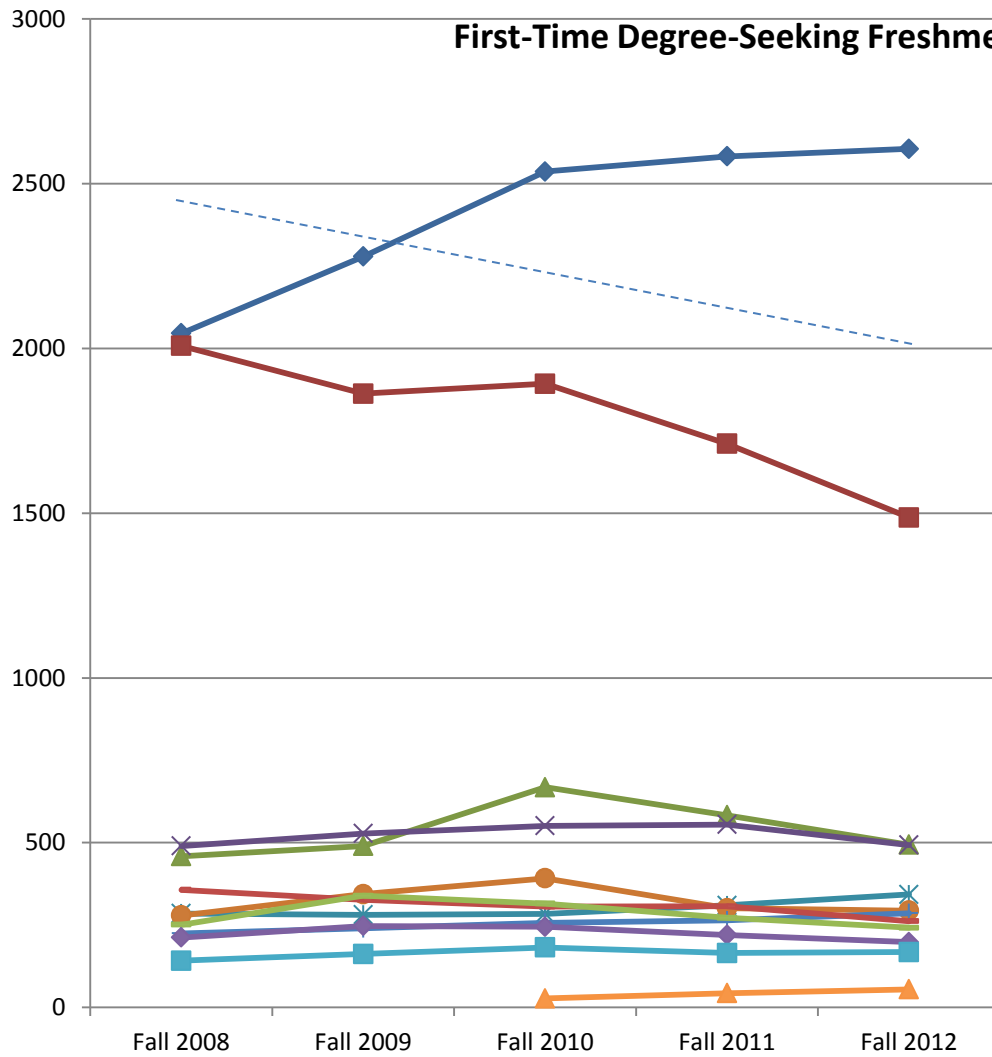

Undergraduate FTE History



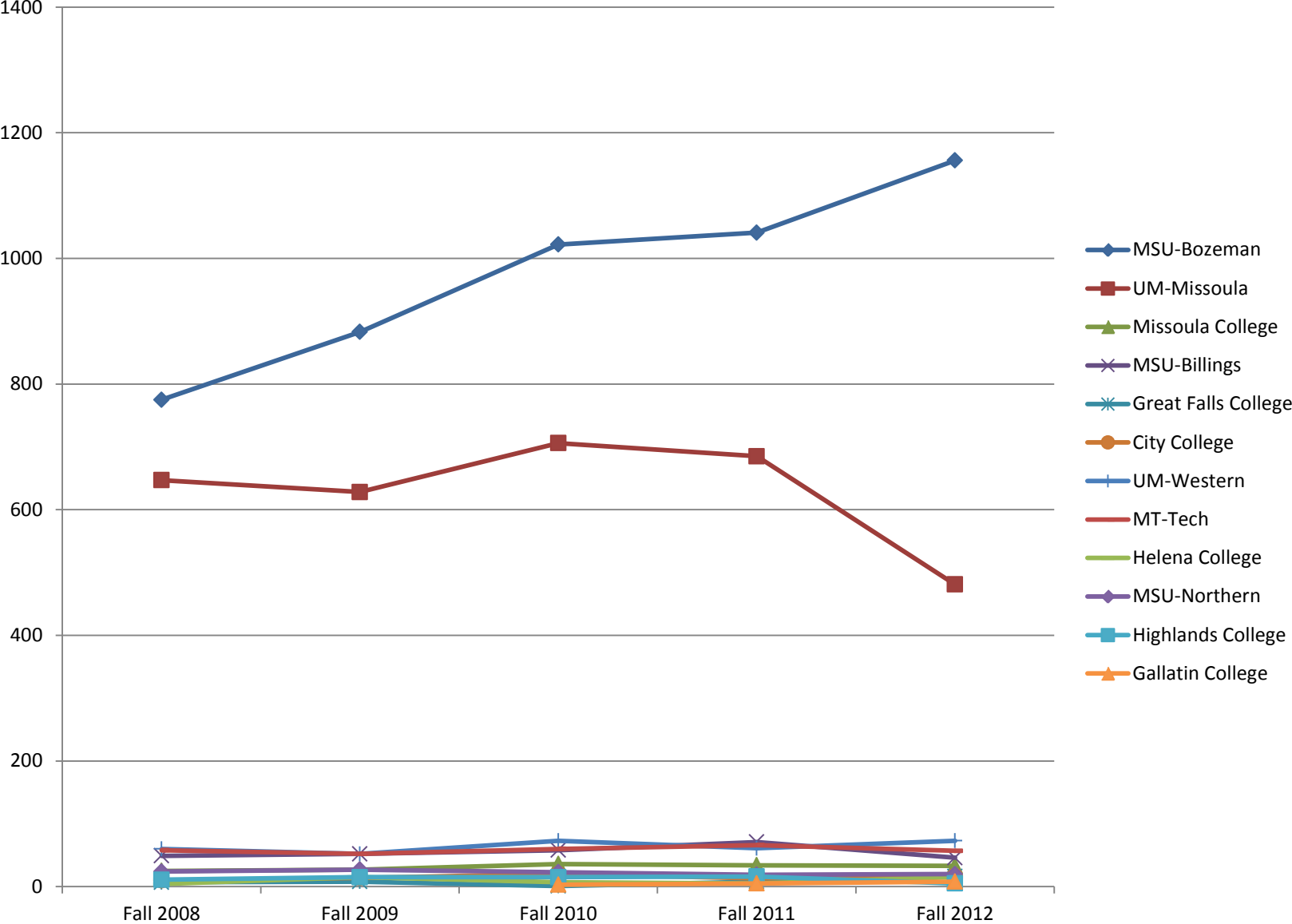

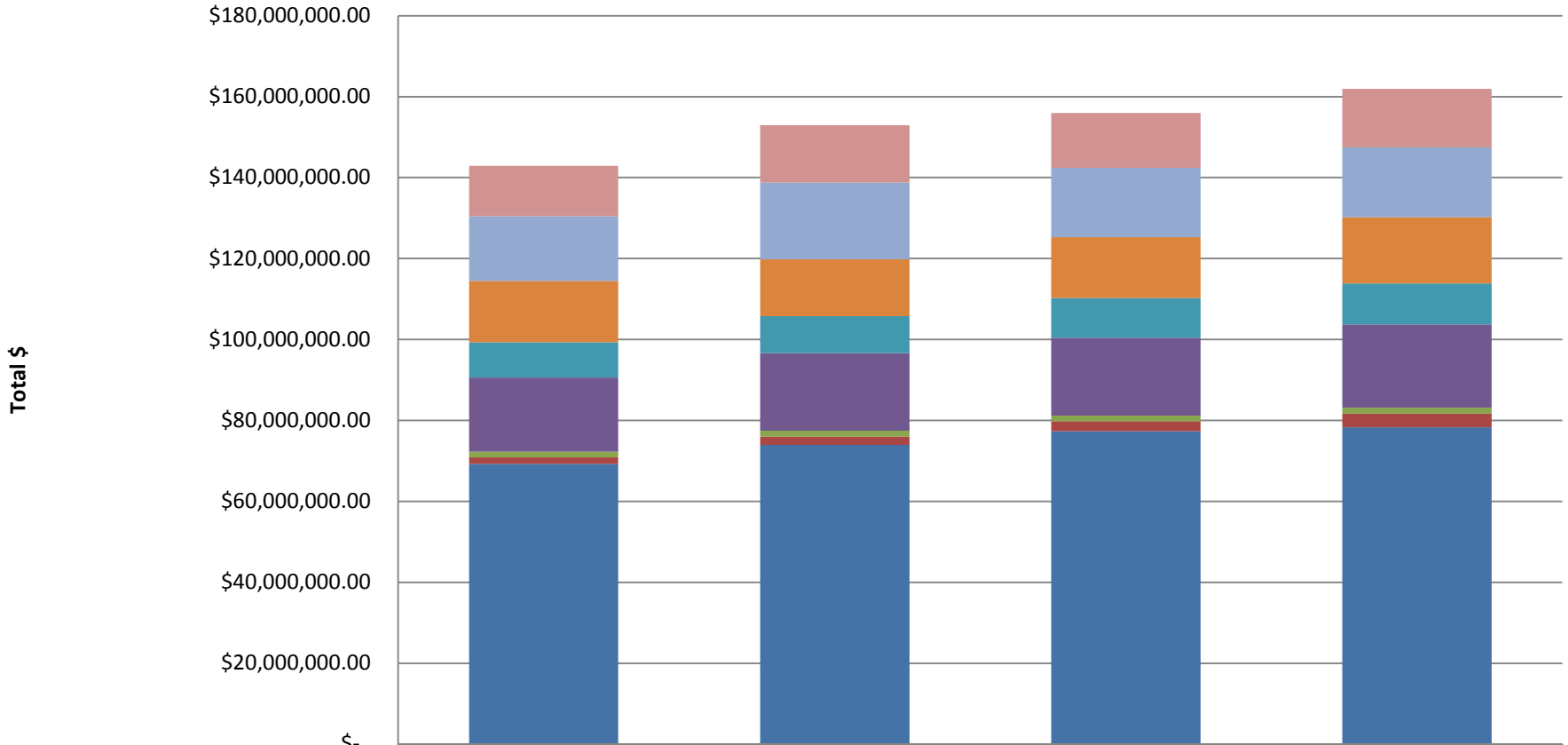

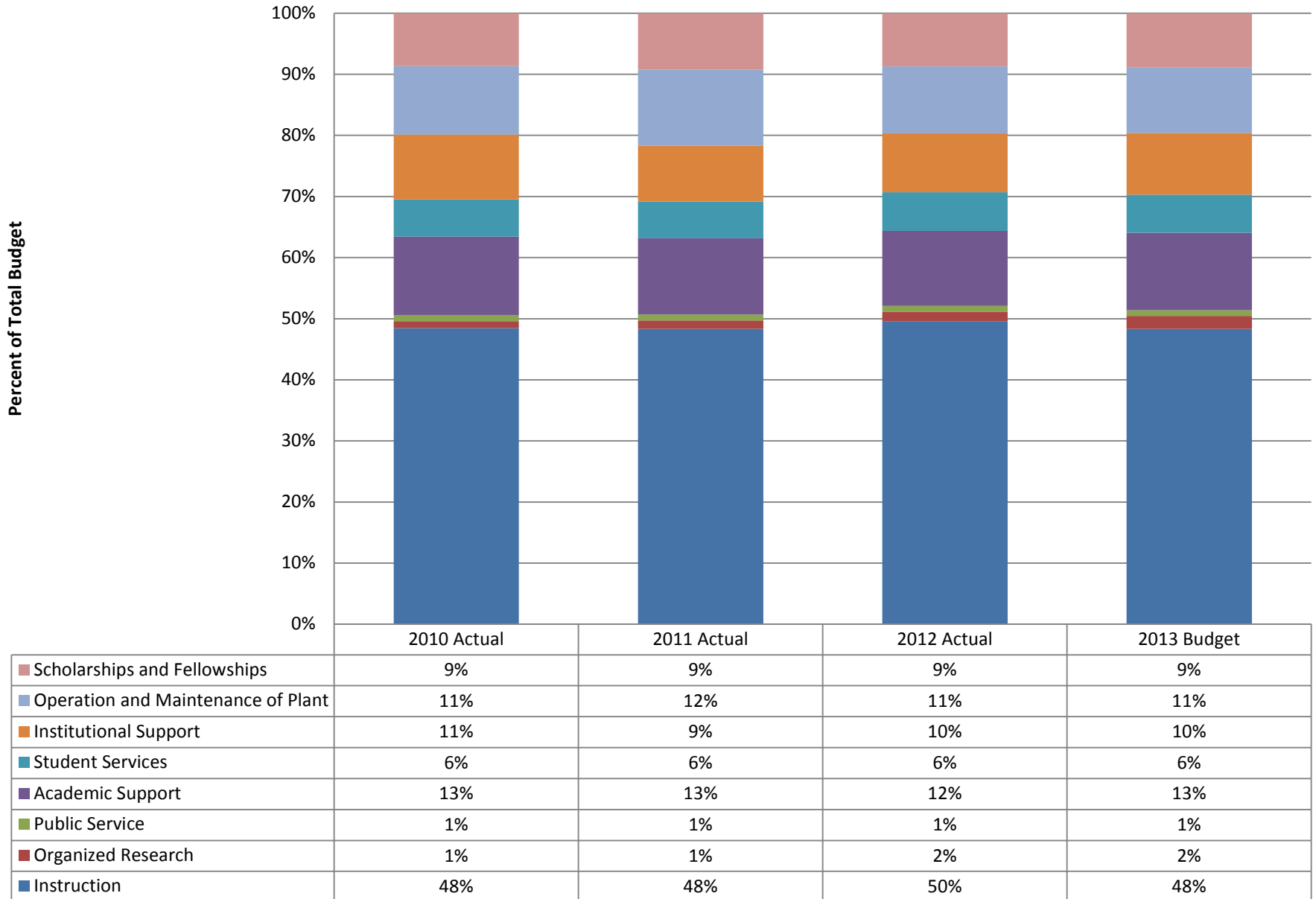
