There are four different teaching and assisting opportunities at the graduate level, **all of which require the applicant to have completed Art G580 (Graduate Teaching Assistant Seminar), or be co-enrolled in that course.** Opportunities require full acceptance into the School of Art Graduate program and full-time enrollment (a minimum of 9 graduate-level credits) at the time of appointment. The four teaching opportunities include:

1. Graduate Teaching Assistantship (GTA) which provides a full tuition waiver for the semester and pays a stipend of \$4,500 per semester. This position requires sole responsibility for teaching a course, and providing 10 hours of service to the School of Art.
2. Graduate Instructor (GI) pays a stipend of between \$1,500-\$1,800 (Depending on Experience) per course per semester and requires sole responsibility for teaching a course (previous teaching-related experience required). Availability of this position depends on curriculum needs for the school.
3. Graduate Assistantship (GA) involves assisting a faculty member with a course, and provides a stipend of \$1,000 per course per semester.
4. Discussion Leader for Art 203L: Intro to Art Criticism, provides a stipend of \$500 per section.
