CAMPUS RECREATION FEE

The fee schedule includes a Campus Recreation fee of \$87.00 for 7 or more state-supported credits. The fee schedule does not include this fee for 1-6 credits. Students enrolled for 6 state-supported credits or fewer have the option of paying the additional fee to cover Campus Recreation.

ACTIVITY FEE

The fee schedule includes a summer activity fee of \$16.00 paid by students enrolled for 4 state-supported credits or more. Students enrolled for 3 state-supported credits or fewer have the option of paying the Activity fee.

RESIDENCY STATUS FOR THE DETERMINATION OF FEES

Undergraduate residency status (resident or nonresident) is determined by information provided by the student on the Admission Application Form, available online at admissions.umt.edu. Questions regarding residency status should be directed to the offices of Enrollment Services - Admissions or Registrar. Graduate residency status is determined by the Graduate School based on the information the student provides on the Graduate School online application.

CURRY HEALTH FEE

The fee schedule includes the Curry Health Fee of \$93.00 for 7 or more credits and allows students to be seen at Curry Health Center. Students

enrolled for 6 credits or fewer pay a \$21.00 Health Fee and may opt to pay an additional \$72.00 Curry Health Fee or pay for services on a Fee-For-Service basis.

PARKING FEES

Current parking decals are required on all motor vehicles, including motorcycles, parked on the UM-Missoula campus during the Summer Semester. Summer Semester parking fees are \$55.00, and decals may be obtained at the Office of Public Safety, Physical Plant.

For short-term parking needs, Day Pass permits are available for \$2.50 at Griz Central, The Bookstore, University Center Customer Service Counter, and the Office of Public Safety. Other short-term parking is available in the metered lots located north and east of the University Center, east of the Mansfield Library, north of Maurice Avenue, south of the Lommasson Center, west of the Gallagher Business Building and between 6th Street and Eddy Avenue (\$.75 per hour).
