Following a three-week orientation period on the Missoula campus, students first depart for Berlin, Germany and spend two weeks exploring the city and visiting various places of historical and cultural interest. The program also pays a visit to Potsdam (near Berlin) and the University of Potsdam, an academic partner of UM. The program then moves to Vienna, Austria, where it is based for the final two months. While in Vienna, students will also make a visit to Budapest, Hungary, Vienna's former sister capital city of the Austro-Hungarian Empire.

In addition to enrolling in five University of Montana courses (16 credits), students will take part in numerous excursions, attend several theater and musical performances, and participate directly in many aspects of European culture and contemporary life.
