DEREE, The American College of Greece, is the largest, oldest American-sponsored college in Europe. Located on a breathtaking hillside at the edge of Athens, DEREЕ's campus offers an ideal setting to study in Greece, providing an expansive curriculum, modern classrooms, an impressive library, and Olympic-quality athletic facilities.

### Academics

DEREE offers 21 majors, 21 minors, & 1000 course per year, including Accounting & Finance, Art History, Business, Communication, Computer Info. Systems, Economics, English, Environmental Studies, History, Info. Technology, International Business and European Affairs, International Tourism & Hospitality Management, Liberal

Studies, Management, Marketing, Music, Philosophy, Psychology, Sociology, Theatre Arts, and Visual Arts. ### Housing & Meals

Exchange students live in DEREЕ's residence complex about two blocks from campus. The two or three bedroom apartments have fully-equipped kitchens, full bathrooms, & balconies.

### Cost Information

Students pay their regular tuition to UM and their room and board to DEREЕ. A double dorm room costs €4,000/semester or €1,700/summer and

meals cost about €1,300/semester or €300/summer. Books cost about €300/semester or summer. UM financial aid can be applied to tuition, living and travel expenses while on this program.

### Credit Transfer

Students will register for classes upon arrival at DEREЕ. Students must take a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester at DEREЕ, which transfers to 12 UM credits, or 6 credit hours for summer, which transfers to 6 UM credits.

### Program Dates

Semester 1: early September to mid-December

Semester 2: mid-February to mid-June

Summer: mid-June to mid-July

## Athens, Greece

### The City

Athens is a city that mixes the ferment modernity with the pull of tradition. The majestic columns of the Acropolis stand guard over a culture that vibrates with the pulse of the 21st century. Conformity is challenged here daily, just like it was challenged 2,500 years ago when democracy & philosophy, sculpture & architecture, theater

& historiography flourished here. It is the place where the liberal arts were born, where thinkers grappled daily with the practical and the existential, and where for the first time ordinary citizens earned the right to elect their representatives. Life in Athens is multicultural and inexhaustible. The city is alive at all hours of the day and night. It has a lively arts scene and those

lucky enough to live here have access to the food, music, culture and traditions of dozens of nations. Moreover, in just a couple of hours, a traveler can visit famous sites of Greek, Roman and Byzantine antiquity and the famous beaches of Attica and the Peloponnese, or bask in the sun-drenched beauty of the Aegean islands.
