

China-Hong Kong Credit Transfer Information

Full-time credit load (undergraduate)

Students usually take four to six classes (12-18credits/units) and spend 12-18 hours in class per week per 13-15 week semester at the Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK). ISEP students are required to take 12 units each semester. One unit is roughly equivalent to one hour of instruction per week. A student with a minimum full-time workload of 12 credits will have an average of 12 hours of lecture per week.
