

Finland Credit Transfer Information

Full-time credit load (undergraduate)

Finnish institutions use the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS). Students should take 30 ECTS credits per semester, transferring as 15 UM credits. A minimum full time load per semester is 24 ECTS credits which will transfer as 12 UM credits.

Upper division

Upper division credit may be granted upon approval by your advisor/department chair upon your return to The University of Montana. Save your coursework and class syllabi to earn such approval.

Grading scale may vary between institutions. Please refer to the grading scale on the transcript. Individual courses at a Finnish university may carry one to several credits, and may last the whole semester or, very often, for much shorter periods during the term.
