

## Ghana Credit Transfer Information

---

### Full-time credit load (undergraduate)

Students usually take five classes and spend 15 hours in class per week during the 16 week semester in Ghana. One Ghanaian credit equals one credit at The University of Montana. The University of Montana students must enroll in at least 12 credits per semester at Ghana.

### Grade conversion

### Upper division

Upper division credit may be granted upon approval by your advisor/department chair upon your return to The University of Montana. Save your coursework and class syllabi to earn such approval.

### Other notes

Letter grades from Ghana are equivalent to US letter grades. Other letters are used in Ghana's system:

"I" - incomplete

"X"- student did not complete the course for reasons adjudged by the Board of Examiners as unsatisfactory.

"Y"- grade given when a course continues into the next semester

"Z"- disqualification from an examination as a result of an examination malpractice or offense.

Please make sure your grades from the courses will appear on your transcript. You should not have a NG (=no grade) as a grade, since if this is the case, UM Admissions office cannot give you credit for the course.
