

## Korea Credit Transfer Information

### **Full-time credit load (undergraduate)**

Students usually take four to six classes and spend 12 to 18 hours in class per week during the 16 week semester. One Korean credit equals one credit at The University of Montana. The University of Montana students must enroll in at least 12 credits per semester in Korea. However, students are encouraged to take at least 15 credits per semester in order to maximize their credit transfer back to The University of Montana.
