

Latvia Credit Transfer Information

Full-time credit load (undergraduate)

Students usually take three to four classes and spend 20 to 25 hours in class per week during the 15 to 16 week semester in Latvia. The Latvia credit refers to an average of 40 hours (one week's study workload), leading to 40 credits per year. One Latvian credit equals 1.5 European Credit Transfer System (ECTS) credits, and therefore each Latvian credit unit will transfer to The University of Montana as .75 credits.
