

Sweden Credit Transfer Information

Full-time credit load (undergraduate)

Students usually take four courses and spend 16 to 20 hours in class per 10 to 15 week semester, transferring back as 12-15 UM semester credits. Also, Sweden uses the ECTS system. Students should take 30 ECTS credits per semester, transferring as 15 UM credits. A minimum full time load per semester is 24 ECTS credits, which will transfer as 12 UM credits. One Swedish point equals 1.5 ECTS and 40 hours of classwork per week.
