

## Aarhus University Credit Transfer Information

---

### Full-time credit load (undergraduate)

The University of Aarhus uses the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS). Students should take 30 ECTS credits per semester, transferring as 15 UM credits. A minimum full time load per semester is 24 ECTS credits, which will transfer as 12 UM credits. Most University of Montana students take three 10-credit classes while at Aarhus. Students who take "Denmark Today" (worth 6.5 ECTS credits) will be awarded an additional 3.25 University of Montana credits.

### Upper division

Classes marked "Upper-level studies" on the Aarhus transcript will be considered upper-division credits at The University of Montana. Other classes taken at Aarhus may be counted as upper-division credits with approval by your advisor/department chair upon your return to The University of Montana. Save your coursework and class syllabi to earn such approval.
