

Providence University Credit Transfer Information

Full-time credit load (undergraduate)

Regular University Classes:

One Providence credit equals one credit at The University of Montana, so The University of Montana students must enroll in at least 12 credits per semester in Taiwan. However, students are encouraged to take at least 15 credits per semester in order to maximize their credit transfer back to The University of Montana.

Classes taken at The Chinese Language Education Center:

15 in-class contact hours is equal to one credit at The University of Montana. To earn 15 UM semester credits, students should enroll in 225 hours of classes. To earn a minimum full time load of 12 credits, students must enroll in 180 hours of class.
