

## Parking for “Who Wants to Be a Mathematician”

Here’s a link to a campus map and driving directions:

<http://www.umt.edu/DiscoverUM/Maps/default.aspx>. The University Center (UC) is near the top of the map. Near the bottom of the page is a link to a parking map. Parking is very difficult on Monday mornings on campus. Here are some options.

1. If you are bringing a bus, please let David Patterson, Chair (243-6748, [dapatterson@mso.umt.edu](mailto:dapatterson@mso.umt.edu)) know so that he can make arrangements with the Office of Public Safety. It will probably be easiest for the bus to unload the kids at the Physical Plant compound (see the complete campus map at <http://www.umt.edu/DiscoverUM/Maps/UM%20campus%20map.pdf>), since there isn’t a good place to unload by the UC. It’s just a short walk from the Physical Plant to the UC. If there’s room, the Physical Plant will usually allow the bus to park there for the morning; if not, they ask that the bus park at the East Broadway Park-N-Ride (see map at <http://www.umt.edu/asum/ot/parknride.html>). There’s a free shuttle from there to campus if the driver wishes to come to campus. For more information, please contact the Office of Public Safety at 243-6131.

2. If you are driving a car or van, there are several options:

- You can park at one of the Park-N-Ride locations (East Broadway or South): <http://www.umt.edu/asum/ot/parknride.html>. There is no charge for the parking and there are frequent free shuttle buses to campus. Anyone can ride the shuttle.
- You can park in an hourly pay spot (75 cents/hour) by the UC. They fill up quickly in the mornings, so you should arrive early. University classes start at 8:10, 9:10, 10:10, etc. It is particularly hard to find a place shortly before 9:10 and 10:10 and there are a lot of cars milling around.
- You can purchase a day pass for \$2.50 at the University Center Bookstore or the Public Safety Office in the Physical Plant. It will allow you to park in any of the A & C Decal Parking Lots. However, a day pass is just a hunting permit and does not guarantee a spot. Again, it is very difficult to find a spot just before the 9:10 and 10:10 classes. The best bets are probably the third floor of the parking garage by the Mansfield Library or the “M” trail parking lot. See the campus map and the parking map (links above).
