- **Students must take a minimum of 4 credits (one 3 credit class and one ensemble) Students may accompany any academic class on some walking tours depending on size of group and the specific class activities. Non-class member participation is determined by the individual professor. However, many walking tours will be available to all students.**
- **178 miles of walking tours! See the homes of Mozart, Beethoven, Schubert and more! Visit the graves of these Vienna composers including Mahler and Brahms. Walk where they walked, listen to concerts in the grand halls that premiered their works. See how they lived and worked!**



## World Class Concerts, Opera and Art

**The Vienna Philharmonic:** Considered by many to be the best in the world! Hear Performances and Open Rehearsals!

**Vienna State Opera:** One of the top opera addresses in the world—where you can hear the best in first-class productions. The famous stage offers a different program every day, with over 50 operas and ballets each season!

**Chamber Music:** Hear the leading-pianists, violinists, cellists, string quartets, contemporary ensembles, vocalists, wind players, brass ensembles, percussionists and period instrument ensembles in the world! They all perform in Vienna as it is “The City of Music!”

Grand Choral Concerts and Performances by the **Vienna Boys Choir** who have an enthusiastic following all over the world. They are often called “the youngest Viennese Ambassadors.”

And they make music together with such world-class musicians as Pierre Boulez, Nikolaus Harnoncourt and Zubin Mehta! There are 100 Vienna Choir Boys between the ages of 10 and 14.

**Museum of Fine Arts** was built in 1891 near the Imperial Palace to house the extensive collections of the imperial family. With its vast array of eminent works, it is considered one of the most eminent museums in the world!

### Program Fees Will Cover:

- Round Trip Flight from Montana or Spokane to Vienna
- Apartment housing
- Salzburg trip: All housing meals, concert tickets and travel for fieldtrip
- All in-country transportation
- Medical Insurance with 24/7 emergency services and fully staffed support for students
- Welcome and Farewell dinner

## Where will I live and study?

### Housing:

**NEW!!** Students will be housed in apartments within the Vienna City Center close to shopping, concerts, classes, museums, faculty and city transportation. Students will stay in shared apartments that will have a bathroom, full kitchen and a living room or common area. Non-Coed Roommates can be selected before leaving Montana. All apartments will have internet access.

### Classrooms and Performance Venues:

Classes will be mostly presented as walking tours, but the central facility for the program will be in the Palais Corballi. This palace is but a few blocks from the Stephansdom, the central cathedral in Vienna. It contains:

- ◆ Classrooms and Practice rooms with pianos
- ◆ A Baroque concert hall with two Bosendorfer Concert Grand Pianos
- ◆ Study room and library with wireless internet, computers and printers

## How much will it cost? **\$6100 TOTAL COST\***

\* Price quoted is for in-state students. Does not include food, except Welcome and Farewell Dinner. Cost dependent on 55 students participating in the program, estimated final airline costs and airline fuel surcharges. Price does not include 50 Euro deposit for "student safety" required cell phone.

Vienna Study Abroad Fee: \$4000 depending on a 55 student program

Estimated Air Fare Fee \$1300

Minimum In-state UM Summer School Tuition for 4 credits: \$800 (Please check the with UM Summer School for Out-of-State tuition rates.)

- Students are encouraged to notify Financial Aid that required courses will be offered during the summer. Financial Aid will allow spring funds to be used for the summer if notified early.
- No-Interest loans are available through the CVPA Student Loan Program. Application forms are available in the music office.



### PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

October 15: Airfare Deposit Due- \$200\*

February 15: Study Abroad Fee Due—\$4000\*\*

April 1: Remainder of Airfare Due— approx. \$900

May 1: UM Summer Tuition Due—approx. \$800

\*100 refundable before April 1

\*\*Prorated refundable rates apply

\*Participation in this program must be approved by the Director of the School of Music. Academic record and student conduct record are determining factors.
