

**Why do I need a NetID?**

A NetID allows campus users to connect to many UM systems and applications with the same login and password. Applications include GrizMail, Blackboard, OneStop, remote library resources, wireless, VPN, and IT computer labs.

*The NetID format includes your first initial, last initial, and six digits.*

**Accessing your NetID**

1. Login to Cyberbear .  
(<http://umt.edu/cyberbear>)  
User ID = 790 number  
PIN = your birth date,  
unless you have already reset it
2. Select *Personal Information*, either in the list or by following the tab at the top of the page.
3. Click on *NetID-Missoula Campus Only*.

Be sure to record your NetID somewhere you can easily retrieve it.

**PIN & Password Information****Cyberbear**

The initial PIN is your birth date in the following format: mmddyy.

Your PIN must be reset every 365 days.

**NetID**

Your NetID password is set in OneStop (<http://www.onestop.umt.edu>).

The initial password is the last six digits of your 790 number.

When setting up your NetID password, you will be asked to select a security question. When you reset your password, you will be asked to answer your security question.

**I don't know my 790 number...**

You can find your 790 number on your Griz Card.
