



Online Application Instructions for International Undergraduate Students

If you do not have U.S. citizenship or legal permanent residency (“Green Card”) and will need a visa to enter and study in the U.S., you are considered an **international student** for University of Montana admissions. If you are not sure about your international status, please email international.admissions@umontana.edu before completing this application.

If you are a **NEW** international student living outside the U.S. and your goal is to complete a degree in person at University of Montana, please follow the instructions below for how to answer questions on the application:

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
