The FAFSA is made available each Oct. 1 for the upcoming academic year. UM's FAFSA school code is 002536. To be considered for the maximum aid from UM, a student should complete the FAFSA by Dec. 1.

## ACT OR SAT TEST SCORES

Testing agencies must send your official scores to University directly. Request that your results be sent to UM through the testing company. UM's ACT code is 2422, and the SAT code is 4489.
