

# PARTNERING WITH MONTANA PAX

## 2024-2025 School Year

### Montana PAX Commitments to Exemplar Districts

- PAX GBG covers the cost of **training** and **kits** for all staff (\$500 per teacher)
- Provide access to PAX GBG training and materials for **new staff** each year you're in the grant
- **PAX Partner support** for 1-2 selected staff
- **Sustainability Coach** Support
- Access to implementation **team training** and support material
- Digital **data** surveys and results surrounding PAX fidelity and student outcomes
- District PAX Mini-grant
  - Funding for replacement materials (posters, harmonicas)
  - PAX Partner Stipend (1-2 partners per school)
  - Funding for sub pay for partner walkthroughs and modeled lessons

### Exemplar PAX District Commitments

- Commit to **staff consensus** building activities to achieve 80% staff consensus (including family, community and school board voice).
- Commitment to create District and/or School **Leadership Team** to support PAX GBG implementation (encouraged to use existing MTSS team).
- Identify at least one staff member to be a **PAX Partner (internal coach)** and provide release time to support PAX implementation
- **Data Collection:** all PAX trained staff will take the PAX Fidelity Self-Assessment data 3 times a year. PAX coach will conduct a School-Wide Evaluation in the spring. PAX Partners will take EIS data for grant outcomes.
- Team will meet with **Sustainability Coach** at least twice a year
- Schedule and **provide ongoing PAX GBG kernels refreshers** and implementation support to staff throughout the year (dedicated staff meeting time, walkthroughs, modeling kernels).
