 *Stats can be fulfilled with: EDU 421, PSYX 222, SOCI 202, or STAT 216. PSYX 222 has an additional pre-req: PSYX 120. SOCI 202 requires a major override from the instructor.
 **Advanced Writing courses include: COMX 347, COMX 413, COMX 414, COMX 421, COMX 422, COMX 424, COMX 445, COMX 447, and COMX 449.
 ***Students taking COMX 460 in the Fall or Spring semester will also be required to take COMX 461. Those taking COMX 460 in summer are exempt from 461.
