**Upperclassman Scholarship
Application**

Amount: Up to \$5,000

The following guidelines apply to the scholarship:

- The George Grant Chapter of Trout Unlimited (GGTU) is making up to \$10,000 available for scholarships for the 2024-2025 academic year. A single student may receive up to a \$5,000 scholarship.
- Only applicants majoring in Fisheries Biology, Hydrology, Civil Engineering, Environmental Engineering, Environmental Sciences, Ecology or similar related fields are eligible for this scholarship.
- Applicants must have Junior or Senior standing for the next term or be pursuing a Master's Degree in the above relevant fields of study.
- Applicants must submit two letters of recommendation from undergraduate or graduate professors.
- Applicants must be pursuing their degree at a college or university within the state of Montana.
- Applicants intending to pursue their initial professional job within the state of Montana will receive higher evaluation scores.
- Applicants that have volunteered for or conducted environmental conservation projects or programs focusing on fisheries, aquatic habitat or riparian health will receive higher evaluation scores.
- Applicants that are members of Trout Unlimited will receive higher evaluation scores.
- Applicants that show proof of or attest to holding a Montana fishing license for the prior 5 consecutive years will receive higher evaluation scores.
- Applicants must complete the application on time to be eligible for the scholarship.
 - **Deadline is May 31, 2024 at 11:59 PM.**
- The Recipient must apply the scholarship to tuition for their degree program.
- All other scholarships and fee waivers (name, type, and amount) received to date must be listed on the application.
- This Scholarship will be paid directly to the student in 2 installments:
 - 50% of scholarship amount for Fall Semester 2024 upon proof of enrollment.
 - 50% of scholarship amount for Spring Semester 2025 upon proof of enrollment AND proof of a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or B- equivalent.

All information will be verified prior to awarding scholarships.
