Boren Awards - Up to \$24,000 for language immersion and study abroad in world regions vital to US interests. Recipients commit to working in the federal government for at least 1 year. Undergraduate and graduate awards available. Open to US citizens.

Congress-Bundestag Youth Exchange - A one-year, fully-funded, exchange program to Germany for US citizens ages 18 - 24. Awardees initially take classes in their field and German, followed by a paid internship of their choosing. Open to all disciplines.

Critical Language Scholarship - A fully-funded language immersion program in one of 14 languages that are critical to US interests. Summer in-country study and year-round virtual study available. Undergrad and grad students who are US citizens may apply.

DAAD - Funding via German Academic Exchange Service for numerous study and research opportunities. Awards for undergraduates, graduate students, and alumni. See www.daad.de/en for full details.

DoD SMART Scholarship - Tuition and professional support for STEM students in majors related to functions of the Department of Defense (DoD). Open to undergrad and grad students who are citizens of the US, Australia, Canada, New Zealand, or UK.

FAO Schwarz Fellowship - Two-year paid fellowship at high-impact nonprofit organizations in Boston, New York City, and Philadelphia. Graduating seniors who are eligible to work in the US may apply.

Fulbright Student Program - Post-graduate and graduate opportunities to teach English, conduct research or creative projects, and attend graduate school in over 100 countries. US citizens may apply starting their senior year of college.

Fund for Education Abroad - Provides scholarships to students who are underrepresented among the US study abroad population.

Gates-Cambridge - Fully funds 1-3 years of graduate study in any subject at Cambridge University. Open to all non-UK citizens.

Gilman Scholarship - Up to \$5,000 to support undergraduates receiving Federal Pell Grants or students of active military families to study or intern abroad. Open to US citizens.

Barry Goldwater Scholarship - Up to \$7,500 a year to support sophomores and juniors intending to pursue research careers in eligible STEM fields. Open to US and Puerto Rico citizens.

James C. Gaither Fellows - One-year fellowships to work in several areas of the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace. Graduating seniors and individuals who have graduated during the past academic year may apply if at a partner institution.

Killam Fellowship (Fulbright) - Up to \$10,000 for undergraduate students from universities in Canada and the United States to spend either one semester or a full academic year as an exchange student in the other country.

Knight-Hennessy - Fully funds 1-3 years of study in any graduate program at Stanford University.

Luce Scholars - Provides stipends, language training, and individualized professional placement for a year in Asia. Open to individuals with an undergraduate degree who are under 32 years old.

Marshall Scholarship - Funds 1-3 years of graduate study in any field at any UK institution. Open to US citizens with a 3.7+ GPA.

Mitchell - Fully funds 1 year of graduate study in Ireland and Northern Ireland. Open to US citizens under 30 with a 3.7+ GPA.

NSF Graduate Research Fellowship - Funds 3 years of graduate study in eligible STEM fields. Open to US and Puerto Rico citizens.

Payne Fellowship - Seeks individuals who are interested in pursuing careers in the Foreign Service of the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID). Funding and benefits for two years for graduate school, internships, and professional development activities.

Rangel Internal Affairs Program / Pickering Fellowship - Prepares young people for careers in the Foreign Service of the U.S. Department of State. Open to seniors and individuals with a college degree who want to promote positive change in the world.

Rhodes Scholarship - Fully funds 1-3 years of graduate study in any field at Oxford University. Open to US and non-US citizens with a 3.7+ GPA.

Schwarzman Scholars - Fully funds a 1-year Master's in Global Affairs at Tsinghua University. Must be 18 - 28 years of age and proficient in English.

Truman Scholarship - Up to \$30,000 in graduate school funding for students interested in a public service career (includes government, education, nonprofit, and advocacy sectors). Open to college juniors or third-year graduating seniors with US citizenship.

Udall Undergraduate Scholarship - Up to \$7,000 for sophomores and juniors committed to careers related to the environment, Native health care, or tribal issues. Native Americans and Alaska Natives may apply to healthcare or public policy fields.

UK Summer Institutes (Fulbright) - Fully funded summer study at one of the various themed institutes around the UK. Open to freshmen and sophomores. Seeks to fund those from historically underrepresented groups or with limited international experience.
