General Audience	Technical language is prevalent throughout the presentation or does not follow a logical progression. Clarity and Engagement	Discussion seems to drift from the project. Presenter uses visual aids that are very poor, disorganized, or detract from the project's logic.	Presentation is well organized, but visual aids are distracting or not well designed.	The presentation is smooth, organized, and engaging. Presenter uses visual aids that enhance the presentation.
Significance and Impact	Importance of work is not clearly stated. Or, applicant doesn't address broader impacts.	Importance of work is stated, but not well developed. Applicant addresses some of the broader impacts of the research project.	Importance of work is clear, concise, and easy to understand by non-specialists. Applicant addresses the significant broader impacts and larger context of the project for the student, university, and/or society.
