**Digital Montana** is an educational workshop that explores the unique role of digital infrastructure in Montana's economy, environment, and culture. The goal of Digital Montana is to equip students with knowledge about the socio-economic and environmental impacts of digital technologies. **Led by MIT faculty and MacArthur Fellow Lisa Parks**, this course provides an innovative and experimental space for students to learn about digital technologies in the field. Working in interdisciplinary teams, students will use various research and experimental practices, including site visits, interviews, drawings, photographs, data collection, and design to investigate various aspects of digital technologies in Montana.
