Navigation and Settings

	Account is personalized to reflect your own profile picture, desired account settings, and customized notification settings. Canvas

	Course Navigation is clear and consistent (unused items are hidden from student view). ■ Canvas Guides: How do I manage Course Navigation links?	
	Course Card image is added to provide a visual representation of the subject. Canvas Guides: How to I add an image to a course card?	
	Import is a tool used to bring in any previous course content or content shared to you by others. As relevant, use the Course Import tool to retrieve past content and activities. ■ Canvas Guide: What is the Course Import Tool?

	Home Page is personalized by replacing the template information with

	Syllabus is available for download and follows the UM syllabus	
ш	template. Items are "Copied and Pasted" directly into the template	
	(recommended) and all unused template placeholders are deleted.	
	Canvas Guides: How do I edit the Syllabus in a course?	
	Getting Started Module is edited to reflect your specific instructor and	
ш	course information. The Instructor Information page is edited to	
	include a short video (recommended). The Course Q&A Forum &	
	Introduction Forum are used for questions and community building. All	
	unused template items and sample text are deleted.	
	Sample Module is reviewed as a suggested structure for organizing	
	your course. A structure is determined based on your instructional	
	strategies and content. All templated activities are reviewed and	
	adjusted with your own text (e.g. discussions, quizzes, assignments).	

Course Design

	MUS Principles of Quality and Canvas Tools is consulted as a document to support quality course design and development.	
	Assignment Groups are created for weighted grade categories (if applicable). ■ Canvas Guide: How do I add an assignment group in a course?	
	Develop Course Content by consulting the UM Canvas Essentials course and/or the Canvas Instructor Guides and Videos for instructions on adding content, activities, and assessments.	
	Chunking of content allows students to engage with manageable pieces of information and activities. Leverage modules and pages (e.g. organized by units, chapters, topics, or weeks). ■ Canvas Guide: What are Modules?	
	Check Alignment of your Syllabus to your course assignments and your gradebook to ensure that course outcomes are met and that the sequencing is logical and increases in understanding and difficulty.	

Course Finalization and Publishing

	Accessibility is addressed by reviewing all content (videos are	
ш	captioned, images are tagged, text clues such as headings and link	
	names are used correctly). Use the Accessibility Checker to identify	
	and correct accessibility issues within the course. Canvas Guide:

	Link Validation is used to check that all links, files, videos, and external	
Ш	URLs are active and working. ■ Canvas Guide: Link Validation	
	Student and Mobile Views are tested to ensure accuracy and access	
ш	from the student role. Canvas Guide: How do I view a course as a

	Publishing your course should occur about one week prior to the start	
Ш	date. Publish and post a course announcement to welcome your	
	students! If your course is published while you are designing the	
	enrolled users will receive email notifications for each change and add
