This program prepares students to address the growing issues related to substance use and addictive disorders. The Addiction Studies coursework provides excellent training to students seeking employment in a broad range of professional areas such as community health, nursing, psychology, social work, and more.

### CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Substance abuse counselors positions are expected to grow 23% through 2030, much faster than the national average. About 41,000 openings for substance abuse, behavioral disorder, and mental health counselors are projected each year, on average, over the decade. In June of 2023, median pay for substance abuse counselors in MT is \$52,450 per year.
