This one-semester certificate program is designed to prepare candidates for entry-level positions across the construction industry. Designed to make students job-site ready, the program covers job-site safety as well as a hands on introduction to site and foundation work and basic carpentry.

CAREER INFORMATION

Construction is a great industry to get into with careers and positions that are in high demand. This certificate can be used as a stepping stone into Missoula College's two-year degree in Sustainable Construction or as a stand-alone certificate. With this certificate, students can start positions in general labor at various residential, commercial and/or industrial job site locations including the organization of materials, clean up duties, flaggers around the job site and assisting carpenters. Hourly salaries in these positions in Montana range from \$14 to \$28 per hour.
