SC indicates a member of the UN Security Council. G-20 indicates a member of the Group of 20. The G-20 is not a UN committee but consists of 19 countries with large economies, plus the European Union. The G-20 accounts for 90% of global gross national product, 80% of world trade, and 2/3 of world population. Although MMUN is not simulating the G-20, it is useful to know which countries belong.
