

HOW TO RESPOND

WHEN AN ACTIVE SHOOTER IS IN YOUR AREA



LOCKDOWN! Locks, lights, out of sight.

STUDENTS

Move away from sight
 Maintain silence
 Do not open the door
 Prepare to evade or defend

INSTRUCTORS AND STAFF

Recover people from hallway if possible
 Close and lock the door
 Turn out the lights
 Move away from sight
 Maintain silence
 Do not open the door
 Prepare to evade or defend

AVOID the threat

distance = safety

If you don't know don't go

Pay attention to your surroundings

Have an escape plan

Move away from the threat

Put distance & Barriers between you & the threat

DENY the threat access to

you

Close door ensure it is locked

Maintain silence

Create barriers to prevent entry

Stay out of sight

Be prepared to DEFEND

DEFEND yourself &

others

Work in groups if possible

Utilize improvised weapons

Distract / Disarm / Disable
 CHEAT - There are no rules!

Be aggressive and committed to your actions

AID

Be prepared to render aid to yourself and/or others

Aid others only when you are safe

Stop bleeding with direct pressure

Bleeding control kits are available in most buildings. Know where they are and how to use them

WHAT TO DO WHEN LAW ENFORCEMENT ARRIVES

REMAIN CLAM

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS

KEEP HANDS VISIBLE

AVOID QUICK MOVEMENTS

AVOID POINTING OR YELLING

AVOID THREATENING POSTURE
