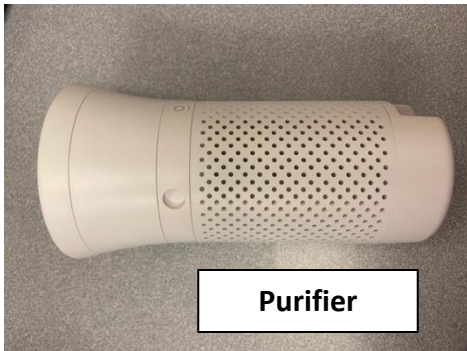


WyndPlus Smart Personal Air Purifier

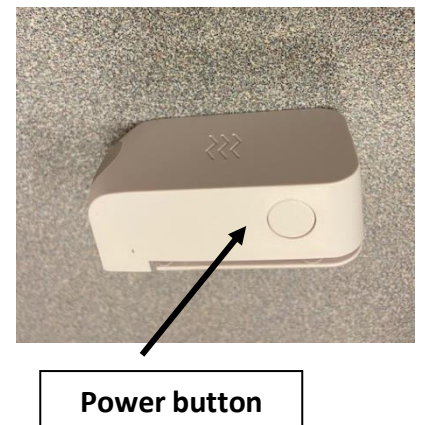
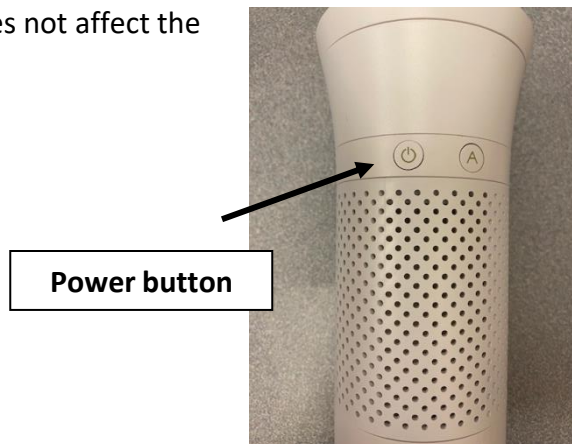
WyndPlus Smart Personal Air Purifier Protocol

Setup

1. The WyndPlus Smart Personal Air Purifier can be utilized alongside the Wynd app for access to its full features. The app can be downloaded on a phone or tablet by visiting <https://shop.hellowynd.com/pages/app>
2. Once downloaded, you will need to pair your phone/tablet app with the Purifier. Open the app and click on “devices” on the lower menu and then choose “Add a new device” on the next screen. Follow the instructions in the app to pair your device with your phone or tablet.
3. There are two components to the WyndPlus Smart Personal Air Purifier, the larger cylinder-shaped Purifier and the smaller, rectangular-shaped Tracker. Note: the Tracker is stored in the bottom of the Purifier and can be removed by sliding it out horizontally.



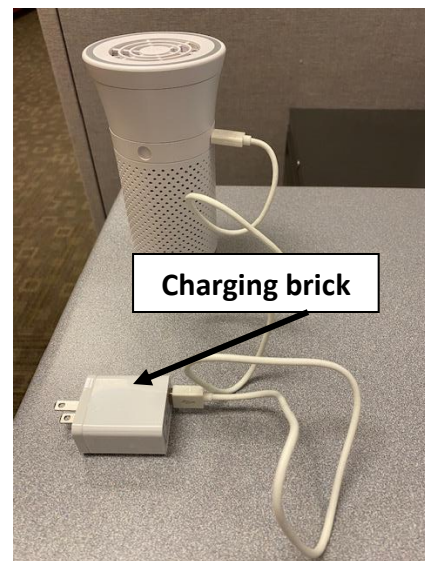
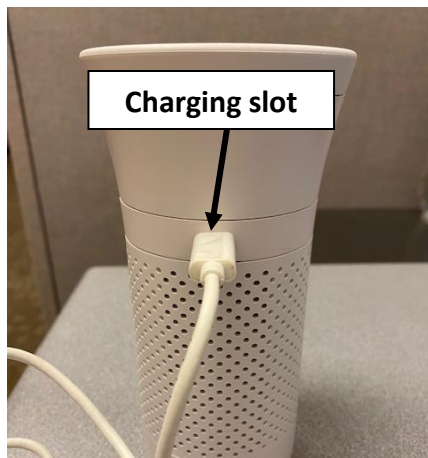
4. The purifier can be turned on and off by pressing the power button located on the side of the device.
5. The tracker can be turned on and off by pressing the power button on the side of the tracker. The purifier's button does not affect the tracker.



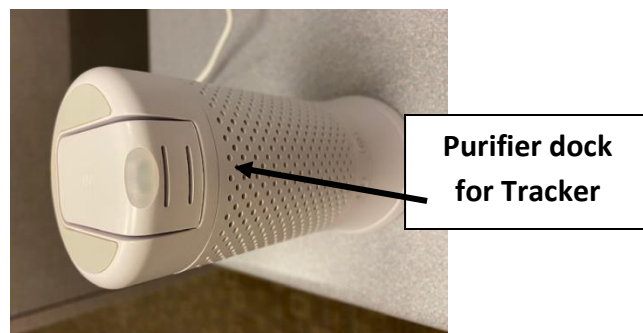
6. Attach the kickstand into the Purifier's attachment points by placing the prongs into the two hollowed out circles on the sides of the device. The kickstand allows the purifier to funnel clean air at an angle.



7. To charge the purifier, plug in the USB-C cable to the slot in the back and plug the other end of the USB-C cable into the included charging brick. Plug the charging brick into an outlet and allow the Purifier to charge for 4 hours before operating it unplugged. Note: you can still use the purifier while it is charging.



8. To charge the tracker, dock it in the Purifier by sliding it in horizontally at the bottom of the Purifier and turn the Purifier on.

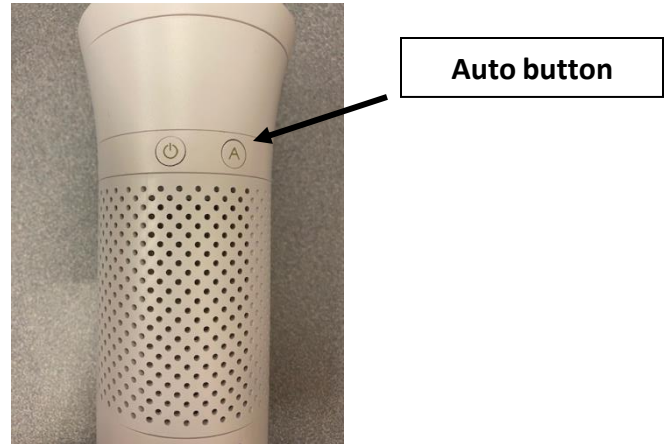


Monitoring Your Air

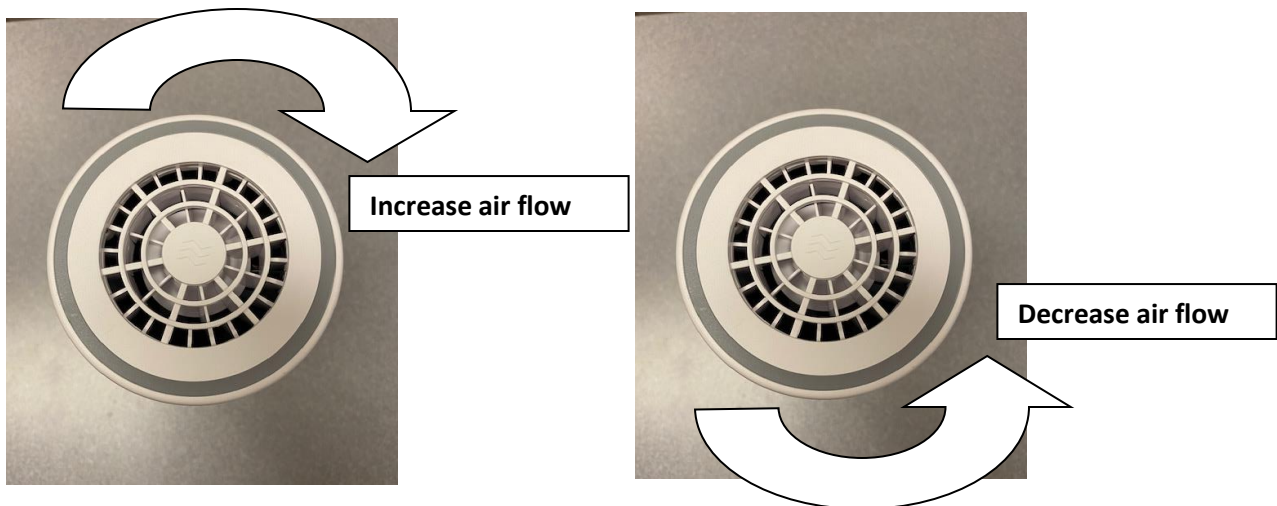
1. The Tracker can be left docked in the Purifier to monitor air quality nearby or can be removed to monitor air quality on the go.
2. The Tracker's light color indicates the air quality in a continuum from Good air quality to Hazardous air quality in the following order: Blue (good), Yellow, Orange, Red, Pink, Purple (hazardous).

Activating Auto Mode and Adjusting Airflow

1. Auto mode can be utilized which will automatically adjust the level of airflow based on the air quality, as sensed by the Tracker. To turn on auto mode, press the Auto button on the Purifier (the button next to the power button marked with an "A").



2. To adjust the airflow, turn the top control ring. Turning the ring clockwise increases the air flow while turning the ring counter-clockwise decreases the air flow.



3. The lights can be turned off on the Purifier if desired by pressing the auto button ("A") on the Purifier twice. Turning off the light also helps the Purifier to save power.

Troubleshooting

Resetting the device can often solve problems associated with the Purifier or the Tracker.

- a. To reset the Purifier, hold down the power button for 10 seconds.
- b. To reset the Tracker, place a pin (or other pointed object) into the tracker's reset hole (the small hole on the end opposite from the light).
