

IACUC Congruency Review of Award Proposals and Contracts Involving the Use of Live Vertebrate Animals

Policy

In accordance with the Public Health Service (PHS) Policy on the Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals, no monies will be released by the Office of Sponsored Programs (OSP) for a PHS, American Heart Association (AHA), or National Science Foundation (NSF) award involving the use of live animals for research or teaching until the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) has reviewed and approved each component of the award proposal that pertains to the care and use of animals. This also applies to contracts awarded through PHS.

PROCEDURE

Please complete and submit this form upon receiving notice of potential PHS, AHA, or NSF funding (new or competing renewal) for conducting live animal research. Include pertinent information as indicated. Similar requirements apply to awarded contracts.

PLEASE NOTE

Failure to submit the required Congruency Review materials in a timely fashion will delay the release of funding. Note that all pending protocols and pending protocol modifications must be approved by the IACUC before a Congruency Review is considered satisfied.
