STUDENT PROPOSALS

POLICY: UM students wishing to conduct research involving human subjects for any course, including thesis, dissertation, research methods or independent study courses shall be subject to the same rules regarding IRB submission of their research proposal as UM faculty. Student projects involving human subjects must be supervised by a UM faculty member who has been approved by his/her department to supervise this type of student research. The faculty member cannot be a supervisor in name only, but must provide actual supervision.

Follow procedures from UM IRB Policy *Courses Involving Students' Investigations Using Human Subjects*.
