



Entry-Level Doctor of Occupational Therapy Program Observation Form

University of Montana's Entry-Level Doctor of Occupational Therapy program requires 20 hours of observation in a minimum of two practice settings that must be completed prior to admission to the program. Examples of settings are: adults (inpatient, outpatient, community-based, etc.), geriatrics (inpatient, outpatient, skilled nursing facility, long term care, etc.), pediatric (inpatient, outpatient, school-based, early intervention, etc.), mental/behavioral health, hospitals, community centers, primary care, etc. This form will need to be completed by the occupational therapist or occupational therapist assistant at each site observed.

This form must be uploaded to OTCAS and submitted by the application deadline in order for your application to be considered complete.
